**ORDER**

(U/S 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005)

Whereas the State Task Force for COVID-19 has formulated **Standard Operating Procedures for returnees entering Sikkim after 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2020.**

Therefore, in view of the above and as per the provisions of section 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, I, Raj Yadav, IAS, District Magistrate-cum-Chairperson, District Disaster Management Authority, East Sikkim hereby direct the following:

1. Any individual desirous of entering the state shall apply for the online permit on the portal <https://registration.covid19sikkim.org/> with all the travel details and personal information.
2. **Smt. Sabitha Choudhary, DIO/ NIC (East), (Contact No: 9800013330)** shall be the Nodal Officer for approving the entry permits for East Sikkim district under the overall direction of the undersigned.
3. Entry through Rangpo Checkpost shall be allowed from **09:00 A.M to 06:00 P.M.** The returnees may travel in scheduled SNT bus service on payment basis from SNT Complex, Pradhan Nagar, Siliguri or by taxis from NJP Railway Station/ Bagdogra Airport till Rangpo Screening Centre.
4. The screening of the returnees shall be done at the screening centre under the overall supervision of the **Chief Medical Officer, East.** The returnees shall be screened at the Screening Centre at Rangpo and sent to the designated quarantine centres in the district in designated buses/vehicles. The Jt. General Manager, SNT shall make necessary arrangements for transportation of returnees to their respective facility quarantine centres in buses from the screening centres in coordination with the Nodal Officer of the screening centre.
5. **All Sikkimese returnees belonging to economically weaker section of the society such as AAY/PHH/OPH categories only shall be allowed to be accommodated in free quarantine centres. All other returnees shall be accommodated only in paid quarantine centres.**
6. The returnees shall be assigned quarantine centres based on the report of the Medical Team and transported to the respective quarantine centre by the Help Desk established at the screening centre under the supervision of the Nodal Officer as mentioned below **w.e.f. 01/07/2020:**

7. The aforementioned teams shall work under the directions of the concerned Nodal Officer. The Nodal Officer shall have the discretion to change the shifts of the teams under him if necessary.
8. The Sub Divisional Magistrate, Rangpo shall ensure the availability of drinking water, toilet facilities and refreshments for the officials engaged in the screening centre and cleanliness of the screening centre in coordination with Municipal Executive Officer, Rangpo Nagar Panchayat.
9. The Sub Divisional Police Officer/ Rangpo shall deploy sufficient police personnel at the screening centre and ensure proper barricading to regulate the movement of the returnees and prohibit unnecessary movement of visitors or public at the screening centre.
10. The Deputy Director, Disaster Management (East) shall make necessary arrangements for sanitisation and disinfection of the vehicles transporting the returnees at the screening centre.
11. All instructions and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) regarding **screening and quarantining of returnees** laid down under Order No. 1833/DC(E)/2020 dated 02/05/2020 shall be strictly followed by all persons concerned.
12. All instructions pertaining to facilitation of **transportation of migrant/stranded labourers** to Siliguri/NJP Railway Station issued vide order no: 1843/DC(E)/2020 dated 12/05/2020 shall continue and be strictly followed by all persons concerned.
13. All instructions pertaining to establishment of **Transit Camps** in East Sikkim district for the accommodation of drivers and helpers transporting essential commodities and goods from outside the state issued vide order no: 1826/DC(E)/2020 dated 19/04/2020 and order no: 1846/DC(E)/2020 dated 14/05/2020 shall continue and be strictly followed by all persons concerned.


This Order shall come into force with effect from 01<sup>st</sup> July, 2020 in the entire area of East Sikkim district and shall remain in force till further orders.
